Our main goals are:

PROTECTION

- Protecting the EU's and the Member States' financial interests and prosperity by collecting duties;
- Promoting the development of fair and legitimate trade and fighting unfair and illegal trade;
- Ensuring the safety and security of citizens against threats, including those from terrorism and against citizens' health;
- Safeguarding the environment, intellectual property rights, and cultural heritage.

FACILITATION

- Enabling the free movement of goods within the EU;
- Implementing the Customs Union;
- Facilitating legitimate business by applying a modern legal framework;
- Aligning working methods supported by an easily accessible electronic customs environment;
- Supporting European business by strengthening competitiveness through fast and reliable processes;
- Providing equal treatment of EU companies no matter where the company is located;
- Simplifying international trade by applying Trade Agreements with the EU's partners worldwide.

FUTURE ORIENTATION

- Embracing modern technologies and promoting innovations through e-services;
- Emphasising the importance of comprehensive approaches to information technology;
- Adapting procedures and processes to future challenges;



- Ensuring systems interoperability and information exchange;
